SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 030-20528/92-01 (NOTICE OF VIOLATION)

This refers to the routine, unannounced inspection conducted by Messrs. Richard A. Leonardi, Jr., and Gilbert L. Guerra of this office on December 14-18, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized by Byproduct Material License No. 15-21332-01. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you during a telephonic exit briefing on January 7, 1993.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice).

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

The inspectors noted that the licensee was anticipating a reorganization in the licensee's management staff. You are reminded that it is necessary to provide timely notification to NRC whenever business decisions could involve changes in the corporate structure responsible for management oversight, control, or radiological safety of licensed materials. In this regard, the enclosed NRC Information Notice No. 89-25 "Unauthorized Transfer of Ownership or Control of Licensed Activities," is provided for your review.


