SUBJECT: SECURITY PLAN REVIEW - REED COLLEGE

In response to your Technical Assistance Request on the above subject we have completed our review of the "Physical Security Plan for Reed College Reactor Facility," submitted by letter dated November 10, 1983. Based on our evaluation, we have determined that the plan meets the requirements of 10 CFR 73.67(f) and (g) for the protection of Special Nuclear Material of Low Strategic Significance. A Regulatory Analysis for the Security Plan is enclosed (Enclosure 1).

Accordingly, we request that License No. R-112 be amended as set forth in Enclosure 2. Please inform the licensee that all previously submitted security commitments are superseded by the commitments of this plan. We further request that you provide this branch (SGFF) with a copy of your transmittal to the licensee on this matter.

It has been determined that Enclosure 1 contains information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, pursuant to Section 2.790(d)(1), such information is deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.

Gentlemen:

This letter refers to the routine safeguards inspection of your activities authorized under NRC License No. R-112 conducted by Mr. A. V. Wieder of this office on August 25, 26 and September 4, 1986. It also refers to the discussion of his inspection findings with you, Vice President McFarland and Dr. Kay on August 26, 1986.

The inspection included examination of activities related to safeguarding special nuclear material as described in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and records, interviews with facility staff and inspector observations.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation enclosed as Appendix A to this letter. The item has been categorized into a severity level as described in the NRC Enforcement Policy, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C.

Your response to this Notice is to be submitted in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201 as stated in Appendix A, Notice of Violation.

In accordance with Section 2.790(d) of NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations, documentation of the findings of your safeguards and security procedures are exempt from public disclosure; therefore, the enclosed inspection report, the enclosed Notice of Violation and your response thereto will not be placed in the Public Document Room and will receive limited distribution.

The response directed by this letter and the enclosed Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.


