In addition to all documents relating to the Report issued by Region I of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on March 6, 1990 following its Inspection of Susquehanna Units 1 and 2 on January 22 through 26, 1990 (hereinafter the "Report"), we wish to obtain copies of any and all subsequent reports, notes, investigations, or dissenting opinions issued by anyone at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission


