Dear Mr. Felton:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act,
5 U.S.C. §552, and 10 C.F.R. Part 9.

William H. Lovelace, who recently left the employ of the NRC, maintained comparative nuclear power plant data in connection with his work on the NRC Caseload Forecast Panel ("CFP"). His files contained applicants' and licensees' cost and schedule estimates for construction as well as Mr. Lovelace's analyses of and conclusions about such information. I understand that he maintained separate files on each nuclear power plant under construction. Each file typically contained one or more CFP reports of site visits to projects and assorted other information related to the project's estimated cost and schedule. I understand that on his departure from the NRC Mr. Lovelace's files were transferred to his superior, Mr. Richard A. Hartfield, in the Maryland National Bank Building at 7735 Old Georgetown Road in Bethesda, Maryland.

I request copies of all the records described above, including but not limited to the following:

1. All records compiled and maintained by Mr. William H. Lovelace in connection with his work on the NRC CFP.

2. All reports and data submitted by applicants and licensees to the NRC CFP for purposes of docketing their applications, including information provided to the CFP during its site visits.
3. All reports, meeting summaries, and site visit decisions issued by the CFP.

I hereby agree to pay the prescribed fees for locating and copying the records sought by this request. In addition, I would be pleased to arrange for our own crew and photocopy machine to reproduce the records to minimize any NRC administrative problems. I understand that at least one other firm was permitted such access to Mr. Lovelace's files after filing a similar FOIA request.

I will be as flexible as possible in arranging to copy the requested records. Please call me if you have any questions about the scope of this request.
