

MATERIALS LICENSE

Amendment No. 1

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 39, 40 and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

Dear Ms. Waldron:

In keeping with what Mrs. Margie Lozano, our consultant RSO, already mentioned to you during your recent visit to Puerto Rico, I am planing to move my private offices, and hence, my private nuclear medicine facilities to a new location. The present address is 700 Europa St.; the new one will be 611 Dr. M. Pavia-Fernandez St., Office No. 113, Pavia Medical Plaza. I have enclosed a drawing indicating the relative locations of present and future offices. (Please note that both are on the same street, it is just that its name changes when one crosses Fernandez Juncos Avenue).

It is my understaning that I need to inform the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on the new location of the licensed activities as well as request your permission to move. This, I believe, requires an amendment to the license, so I am enclosing a check for \$460.00 to cover the fee involved.


Also enclosed please find a drawing of the nuclear medicine area at the new location. It is understood that as soon as we vacate the present offices, Mrs. Lozano will survey the area for radiation levels and for removable contamination before it is handed over to the owner of the building as "ready for new occupancy".

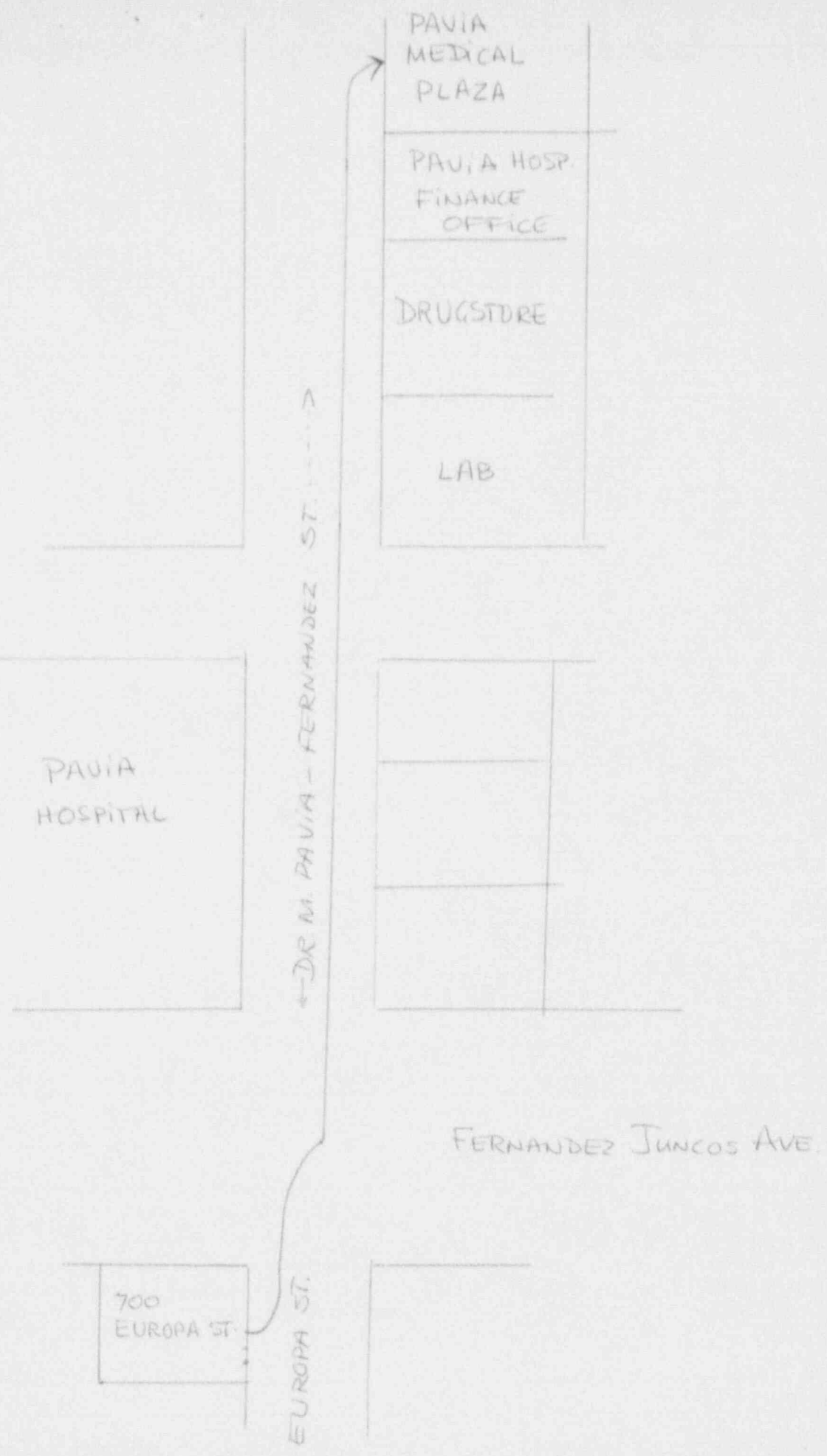

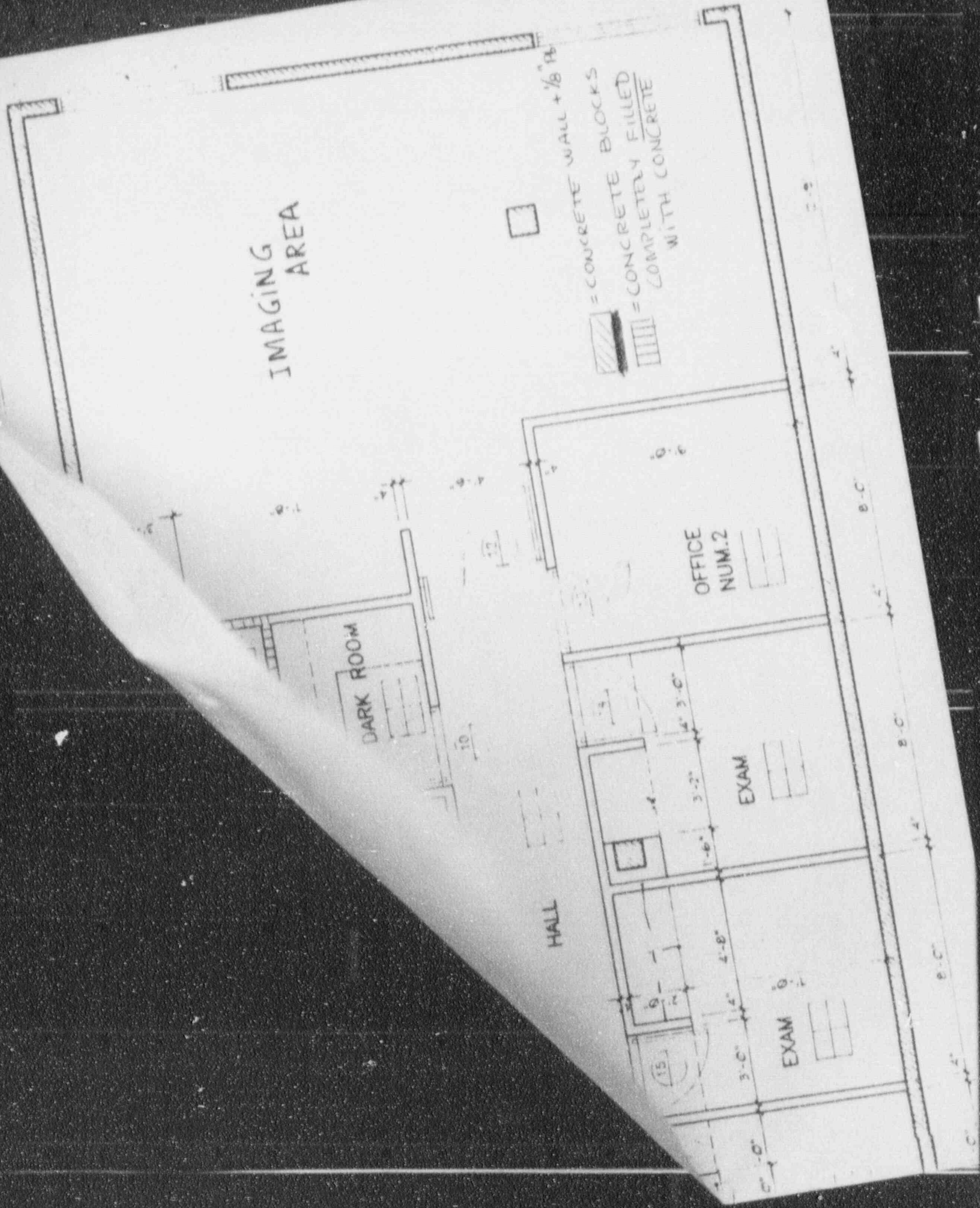
