In a telephone conversation on 3/13/68 between Roeder and Sutherland the subject inspection scheduled for 3/14 and 15/68, was discussed. It was agreed that if there was not a compelling need for an approval to operate in writing, we would not give such a written approval. If there was a compelling need, such as the Navy demanding it of the licensee, then Peery would find out what individual was making the demand, etc., and call this information into the CO:II office. Then, in conjunction with CO:HQ, a call or written communication could be made.

Roeder also said that we should not handle the inspection as a 591, 592 or 417 case since no material will have been received or used. It was agreed that it would be written up as a "Pre-operation Inspection" memorandum and copies forwarded to CO:HQ. It was also agreed that we could go ahead and count as an initial inspection for statistical purposes (5 x 8 card data, etc.).

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
