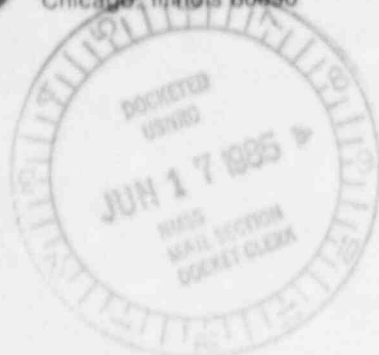




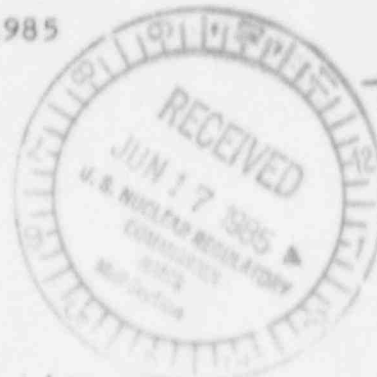

Dear Mr. Davis:

This letter should clarify our application regarding the qualifications of the Fuel Handling Foreman. The clarification is needed because the ANSI standard which was referenced outlines qualifications at time of core load and your reviewer is additionally concerned with qualifications prior to receipt of fuel.

Section 2.2.2 of the Braidwood SNM License Application states that new fuel is handled under the supervision of the Fuel Handling Foreman. The minimum technical qualifications for the Fuel Handling Foreman shall be in accordance with Section 4.3.1, "Supervisors Requiring AEC Licenses," of ANSI N18.1-1971, which in Braidwood's case is a limited SRO per B/B FSAR Section 13.2.1.4. The ANSI standard requires that the Fuel Handling Foreman shall hold an appropriate AEC license at the time of initial core loading or appointment to the active position. Since the first NRC Operator License Exam for Braidwood is presently scheduled to be given in the fall of 1985, the results of the exam may not be known prior to fuel receipt. For this reason, the Fuel Handling Foreman may not be licensed at the time of fuel receipt, but will hold, as a minimum, a limited SRO at the time of core load.

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
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In summary the Fuel Handling Foreman will have the qualifications regarding nuclear experience, but may not have a license at time of fuel receipt.
