Gentlemen:

In reference to the telephone conversation on 01/26/93,
additional information requested by Gary L. Shear is as follows:

- R.S. Scott Associates, Inc. agrees with Violation #1, as described in the certified letter dated 01/08/93.
- Violation occurred in the summer of 1991 at an excavation site in the City of Harbor Springs, when an unauthorized person moved the nuclear gauge, without the knowledge of the authorized user.
- Corrective action as follows: I plan more unannounced visits to the construction sites beginning our '93 construction season, and to immediately check on status of the gauge, use and location, and also check for film badges. First audit will be when the field construction season starts.
