

Dear Mr. Taylor:

This is to confirm the May 3, 1985 telecon between I. Villalva, NRC, and W. J. Johnson, Westinghouse Nuclear Safety Department, regarding failure of the diesel generator at the Philippine Nuclear Power Plant (PNPP). Confirmation has been received from Westinghouse, Round Rock, manufacturers of the generator, that only four such units have been produced by them (including the Philippine unit). Two were supplied to PNPP and two to Kori 2. There have been no diesel generators of this type supplied to U.S. nuclear facilities.
