Gentlemen:

It is our understanding that the licensee of the referenced utilization facilities are obliged to file NRC/ERDA forms 742 & 741 pursuant to 10 CFR 70.53 and 70.54.

As intervenors in the referenced dockets, we customarily receive copies of most licensee reports to the Commission; however, our files are devoid of any 742 or 741 report. The local Public Document Room at the Minneapolis Public Library is one repository for all documents on the referenced dockets; however, their ascension lists do not reveal the presence of any 742 or 741 report.

We have several questions. First, are we correct in believing that the licensee must comply with Parts 70.53 and 70.54? Second, has the licensee complied and if so, why do those reports fail to exist in our local Public Document Room? Third, precisely where in NRC are 742 and 741 reports filed and maintained? If the licensee of the referenced dockets has filed said documents, what are the dates of their filings and may we be supplied with copies of the most current report for each docket?
