Certification

Dear Tom:

I hereby submit the following information in support of my request to add my name to the certification list for the Troxler 3400 nuclear density testor.

My experience with the nuclear density tester includes the following:

1. Tri-State Airport Slide repair in the summer of 1977. Troxler was used for a period of approximately three months to test earth densities on a 55,000 C.Y. embarkment. Tests were performed at each vertical lift through a height of more than 150'.
2. Altizer storm sewers in the summer of 1977. Troxler was used daily for a period of about two weeks to perform earth density on each lift of backfill of a 25 foot high fill over a 72" concrete pipe passing through a temporary opening in a concrete flood wall.

My name is currently on the State of Pennsylvania list for a Troxler model 2400. I would like to have it added to the list for the Troxler 3400.
