Gentlemen:

This is in reference to your application dated February 13, 1985 for a byproduct material license. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Please identify the type of personnel monitoring equipment you will be using and the frequency at which the film badge or TLD's will be changed. Film badges used for neutron monitoring must be on a monthly exchange frequency.
2. Your application states that when transporting gauges which contain licensed material, in an open bed vehicle, the gauge should be securely fastened and locked to the truck bed. We feel the phrase, "should be securely fastened," is not appropriate and leaves room for other possibilities or occasions where the gauge would be left unsecured. Please confirm that this phrase will be changed to, shall be securely fastened.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply in duplicate to my attention at the Region I office and refer to Mail Control No. 03429.
