SUBJECT: RENEWAL OF UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA CAVALIER OPERATING LICENSE

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has issued Amendment No. 4 to Facility Operating License No. R-123 for the University of Virginia CAVALIER training reactor in response to the application for renewal dated June 22, 1984, as supplemented. This amendment renews the operating license for twenty years from its date of issuance.

In accordance with our practice, we have restated the license in its entirety, incorporating all the changes and amendments made since the issuance of the original license.

Enclosed with the amended license are copies of the Notice of Renewal that is being sent to the Office of the Federal Register for publication, the Notice of Finding of No Significant Environmental Impact which has been published in the Federal Register, the Environmental Assessment and the Safety Evaluation Report (NUREG-1119) associated with the renewal.

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
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
