Nuclear Device Reg. No. 84-81 Serial No. M 10083390 was taken by Pat Morrissey of Con Spec Associates, P.O. Box 323, Fairhaven Sta., New Haven, CT., to sell for Arute on 3/23/84.

On July 2, 1984 Con Spec Associates purchased the device from Arute Brothers, Inc.

This device had been in storage since 11/24/82. The last activity on this device while in our possession was a Leak Test taken on March 23, 1984 by Pat Morrissey of Con Spec Associates.

This device is a Campbell Pacific Nuclear Portaprobe MC-1-82 Serial No. M10083390 with substances used in this device all being self contained (sealed Source).

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
