The services of these men as licensed operators are required for the continued operation of the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant located near Monticello, Minnesota. The applications for senior operator licenses for the six employees is made on the basis of probable future need for their services as senior licensed operators. Presently, in addition to the six senior operator licensed Shift Supervisors, we have only two additional shift operators with senior operator licenses.

Each of the six licensed applicants has remained actively engaged in plant and reactor operations and has performed his duties and responsibilities in a safe and competent manner. Through self study and with the benefit of the retraining program, these men have maintained a thorough knowledge of the reactor and reactor control systems, instrumentation, and operating procedures for normal and abnormal conditions. It is my belief that each of the six applicants is capable and qualified to be a Licensed Senior Operator at the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant.

Tentative arrangements have been made with Mr. Robert Campbell of the Operator Licensing Branch to have the senior operator examination given at the Monticello plant site on March 7, 1974.
