General Information

Dear Sirs:

In correspondence date 20 September 1985, we requested an amendment to our current teletherapy operating license to possess a Picker C-9 Cobalt-60 unit. At the time of installation of this unit, AMS was to have taken possession of our existing C-1000 Cobalt-60 unit and remove it (and the source) from the hospital. An amendment was granted.

Please note that AMS has again notified the hospital of a production delay of approximately 3-9 months. As such, we are still in possession of our Picker C-1000 unit.

Due to the age of this unit, AMS representatives have declined to provide a 5-year preventive maintenance. The unit has been taken out of service. It is currently on site at the hospital awaiting removal (or 5 year P.M.) by representatives of AMS.

As per our licensing agreements, we will notify the NRC of the status of the C-1000 and of the installation of the C-9 unit by AMS representative.
