Dear Mr. Thorne,

With reference to our letters of July 6, 1983, May 8, 1984 and March 12, 1985 we kindly ask you to amend the export license XSNM-02011 as follows:

Increase the quantities

from 24 kgs of U-235, contained in 600 kgs uranium, in the form of uranium hexafluoride as "heels" enriched to 4.0 w/o maximum

to 48 kgs of U-235, contained in 1200 kgs uranium, in the form of uranium hexafluoride as "heels", enriched to 4.0 w/o maximum.

All other data of our letters of July 6, 1983, May 8, 1984 and March 12, 1985, remain unchanged.
