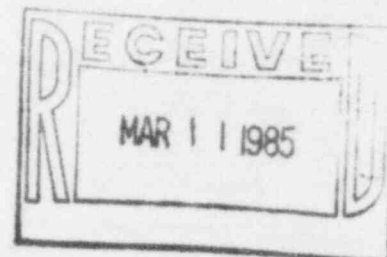

I am sorry for my delayed reply to Mr. Whitten's letter of January 16, 1985. I misread the letter thinking it was an advisory letter only. Thank you for your reminder letter of March 5, 1985 on this important subject.

In reference to Mr. Whitten's letter, the documents referenced in his paragraph's one and two, are available for inspection at each temporary job site and at each field station. Written instructions for transporting devices in our vehicles are contained in the WPS Radiation Safety Manual in SPM 60-04-2, paragraph III and 60-05-2, paragraphs II, III and V. I have enclosed an additional copy of this procedure for your reference. I believe that our procedures in this area generally follow your "Guide for the Preparation of Application for the Use of Radiactive Materials in Well-logging Operations" (Draft dated October 1981), Appendix B, paragraphs 4 and 5.
