Although not required for six weeks or until the middle of March we have enclosed for your review our draft conceptual plan for the remediation of the Curtis Bay land parcel and buildings.


As you will note, Phase 1 will involve the demolition of the roofs, walls, and the heavy vegetation around the buildings. Since the County owns the buildings and property the completion of this initial phase is completely their responsibility. Once Phase 1 is completed, we will then decontaminate the radioactive contamination on the floors, beams and in the soil beneath the buildings.

We have provided an idea of what we expect with regards to how long this project will take, however, this is a rough estimate and will surely increase due to lag time for contractor responses and contract negotiations. The actual work to complete this contract should only be about 30 days.

Please review this document as soon as possible so we may transmit a final copy to the Anne Arundel County Executives and the State of Maryland DEM for their information and coordination.
