Gentlemen:

Per telephone discussion with your office on November 15, 1983, the following is being submitted in response to your letter of October 3, 1983, granting Amendment No. 3 to the subject license. In your letter you requested wipe test results prior to releasing our Radioisotope Laboratory (Rm. 172B) to unrestricted use.

We conducted such wipe tests prior to releasing this laboratory to its new use and the results are well below acceptable surface contamination levels; however, we wish to correct a misunderstanding concerning the new use of this particular laboratory.

We relocated a "Strictly Controlled" laboratory to another location in the same building and converted the vacated room to an ordinary laboratory using isotopes (i.e. "controlled" area) as defined in our original application for license. The vacated room has not been released for "unrestricted use".

Per our telephone discussion with your office, we will retain these wipe test records at our site for your inspection. At such time that we convert any laboratory to "unrestricted" use, we will send in the required decontamination report to your office.
