MATERIALS LICENSE

Amendment No. 1

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 39, 40 and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

13. In addition to the possession limits in item 8, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35 for establishing decommissioning financial assurance.

14. The licensee shall maintain records of information important to safe and effective decommissioning at the licensee's facilities located at 611 Dr. M. Pavia-Fernandez St., Office No. 113, Pavia Medical Plaza, Santurce, Puerto Rico pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.

15. Except as specifically provided otherwise in the license and as provided in 10 CFR 35.51, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents including any enclosures, listed below. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
