SUBJECT: REPORTING OF SAFETY AND RELIEF VALVE FAILURES AND CHALLENGES -  
TMI ACTION PLAN II.K.3.3.

Re: Haddam Neck Plant and Millstone Unit 1

By letter from W. G. Counsil to D. Crutchfield dated May 30, 1984, Northeast Utilities responded to the need for additional technical specifications regarding reporting requirements for safety and relief valve failures and challenges, (NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.3) for the Haddam Neck Plant and Millstone Unit 1.

The staff agrees that the reporting requirements of NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.3 are covered by the confirmatory orders issued on July 7, 1981. The staff also notes that such reporting requirements are implicitly covered by the reporting requirements of 10 CFR 50.72 and 50.73, which became effective January 1, 1984. In your May 30, 1984 letter, you have clarified your commitments for reporting relief valve and safety valve failures and challenges to meet the current requirements of the confirmatory order and 10 CFR 50.72 and 50.73. The staff has reviewed your positions in the May 30, 1984 letter and has found your position of not incorporating additional reporting requirements into the technical specifications to be acceptable.
