This letter is in response to your notice of the proposed rule on license fees dated April 24, 1992. We applied for a renewal of our license no. 45-01378-02 for industrial radiography on October 5, 1990. Due to a backlog of license renewals, it took 8 months for a response to our renewal application; on July 25, 1991 we received a request for additional information. On January 29, 1992, we changed our renewal status to "Storage Only" (30 to 3P status). We have not used our isotopes since June 11, 1991 and feel we should be charged for a "Storage Only" license, and not for an "Industrial Radiography" license for 1992. We are presently using outside contractors for all radiography on a trial basis during the time we have a "Storage Only" license. We would appreciate a resolution to this matter before the next billing cycle.
