You should provide up-to-date information on your safety and control procedures for usage of the sources authorized in License Number 37-01563-03

When you resubmit your application, please include a description of your program for maintaining occupational radiation exposures as low as reasonably achievable (ALARA). A model ALARA Program you may adopt is shown in Appendix O of Regulatory Guide 10.8 (enclosed).
