



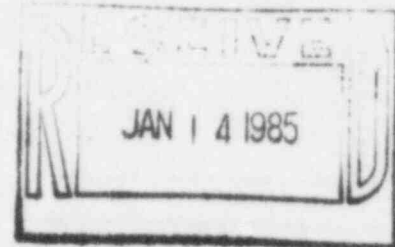

Arkansas Nuclear One 1985 Exercise

Gentlemen:

The 1985 exercise of the Arkansas Nuclear One Emergency Plan has been scheduled for April 24, 1985. This is a coordinated date between the State of Arkansas and the Arkansas Power and Light Company.

Consideration was given originally to a late March exercise date, however, the completion of the Unit Two outage and the announcement by FEMA of the Alert and Notification System Audit in February significantly impacted that time frame. We have reviewed our three previous exercises to verify that this date will not cause us to exceed 3.25 times the specified interval when combined with the previous intervals. This date will also be within the $\pm 25\%$ criterion.

The time line of significant events leading up to the exercise date is as follows:

Tuesday, January 22, 1985 - Submission of Objectives for the 1985 Exercise to NRC and FEMA

Wednesday, February 6, 1985 - Meeting with representatives of NRC, FEMA, Arkansas Department of Health, State Office of Emergency Services and AP&L to review the exercise objectives and scope.

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
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January 2, 1985

Friday, March 8, 1985 - Detailed description of the exercise scenario and actions anticipated by the licensee and offsite authorities to be submitted to NRC and FEMA. The submission will include complete controller packages.

Wednesday, April 24, 1985 - 1985 Exercise to be conducted.
