On June 15, 1985 at 0700 A.M., Central Station Alarm operator received a telephone call from the Suffolk County Police Department (SCPD), 6th Precinct, over the SCPD/Shoreham direct tie-line telephone, reporting the receipt of a bomb threat against the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station (SNPS). The SCPD advised that a call had been received over the 911 number from an unidentified individual who stated, "We are a group that placed a device in the LILCO Containment Building. I suggest you evacuate immediately". Emergency Plan Unusual Event procedures were implemented and a security alert declared. The site was not evacuated. The site was searched, but no explosive device was discovered. The emergency was terminated at 0815 A.M. and normal operations resumed.


