SUBJECT: LOSS OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL (Reference PNO-IV-85-12)

The licensee reported by telephone at 10:30 a.m. CDT on June 28, 1985, that the previously reported stolen moisture/density gauge had been found by an individual along a highway near Big Piney, Wyoming. The gauge was taken to the local sheriff and reportedly indicated no signs of tampering or damage. The licensee representative stated that a leak test would be performed.

The NRC does not plan to issue a press release, but will respond to any media inquiries.

The state of Wyoming has been notified by NRC.
