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

Please be advised that, pursuant to 10 CFR Part 9.5(a)(4), Robert-James Sales, Inc. (the "Corporation"), through us, hereby requests that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission withhold proprietary information set forth in the Commission's Inspection Report No. 99901002/85.01. The information requested to be withheld consists of the names of certain customers of the Corporation. Pursuant to 10 CFR Part 2.790(b)(1) and 2.790(b)(4), enclosed is an affidavit executed by the President of the Corporation supporting its request.

The Corporation requests withholding because it holds the names of its customers in confidence in the ordinary course of its business; the names of its customers are not available from public sources; such information was transmitted to the Commission's inspectors in confidence; and the confidentiality of its customer lists is of primary importance to the business operations of the Corporation.

The undersigned, JAMES W. BOKOR, being duly sworn,
deposes and says:

1. I am the President of Robert-James Sales, Inc., a
New York corporation with its principal place of business at
269 Hinman Avenue, Buffalo, New York, 14216 (the "Corporation").

2. I am authorized on behalf of the Corporation to
request the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to withhold and redact
proprietary information set forth in the Commission's Inspection
Report No. 99901002/85-01 (the "Report"). The information as to
which the Corporation requests withholding and redaction consists
of the names of the Corporation's customers, as stated in the
Report.

3. Attached to this Affidavit as Exhibit A, and in-
corporated by reference herein, is a marked copy of the Report,
indicating the proprietary information requested to be withheld
and redacted.

4. The information requested to be withheld and redacted was submitted to the Commission's investigators, J.T. Conway and J.J. Petrosino, with my request that the Corporation's customer lists and customer information not be disclosed.

5. Attached hereto as Exhibit B, and incorporated by reference herein, is a copy of the Corporation's written request, delivered to the above-named investigators at the exit interview they conducted at the Corporation's premises, asking that the Commission omit or delete all references to customer names, sales figures, and similar confidential or proprietary information.

6. The Corporation holds the names of its customers and its customer lists in confidence in order to protect its market position and its customers' privacy.

7. Customer information and customer lists developed by the Corporation are valuable to the conduct of its business.

8. Upon information and belief, the Corporation's competitors also hold their customer lists and customer information in confidence because of the competitive nature of the industry in which they are engaged.


9. Upon information and belief, information concerning the identity of the Corporation's customers is not available from public sources.

10. Upon information and belief, identifying the customers whose orders were the subject of the Commission's Report is not necessary to convey to third parties reviewing the Report the specific nature and severity level of the violations alleged therein.
