We have evaluated your responses and find that you have already taken some significant steps toward bringing your program back within the Agreement State guidelines. As noted in our letter of April 26, 1985, there will be a followup review in six months, after which we will be in a better position to consider what finding should be made concerning the adequacy and compatibility of your radiation control program.
