modifications associated with fire barrier penetration seals on certain vents  
and drains have been avoidably delayed beyond their original scheduled  
completion." This statement should have read, "... have been unavoidably  
delayed beyond their original scheduled completion." A copy of the corrected  
page for the stated NRC Safety Evaluation is enclosed. The NRC staff's  
conclusion that the amendment is acceptable is not affected by this  
correction.
