The Appeal Board received today several copies of your "Answer Opposing Request for Expedited Review of ALAB-809 and Relief by Phila. Elec. on 6/20/85." From the address on the envelope, your intent was apparently that these copies be delivered not only to the Appeal Board, but also to the Licensing Board and the NRC staff counsel. We would appreciate your cooperation in the future to ensure that all of your filings are docketed properly and are received in a timely fashion by the appropriate individuals.
