Gentlemen:

Enclosed is AEC Source Material License No. STB-440, as renewed.

Please note that this license authorizes processing of the Nigerian ores in accordance with procedures specified in your license application and supplements thereto but authorizes storage only of the uranium-thorium containing residues. Inasmuch as you have not in the past described the proposed residue process we will require a description of the proposed process activities including the ventilation equipment and your radiological safety survey program associated therewith prior to amending your license to authorize these activities.

In addition, this license does not authorize the averaging of employee exposures to airborne radioactivity over a 160 hour, 28 day period inasmuch as your work schedule does not presently appear to be as represented in your letter of September 9, 1961. If you still desire to average exposures in this method, please request an amendment to the license including your reasons therefor and a copy of your present employee work schedule.
