NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Industrial NDT Company

The following violation was identified during an inspection conducted on May 21, 1985. The Severity Level was assigned in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C).

10 CFR 20.205(b)(1) requires a licensee, upon receipt of a package containing quantities of radioactive material in excess of the Type A quantities specified in 10 CFR 20.205 and other than those transported by exclusive use vehicle, to monitor the radiation levels of the package. It requires the licensee to monitor the package as soon as practicable after receipt, but no later than three hours after the package is received at the licensee's facility if received during the licensee's normal working hours, or eighteen hours if received after normal working hours.

Contrary to the above on March 6, 1985, the licensee, upon receipt of a package containing 96 curies of Iridium-192 and not delivered by exclusive use vehicle, did not monitor the radiation levels of the package until March 14, 1985.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violation; (2) the reasons for the violation if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

Security or safeguards information should be submitted as an enclosure to facilitate withholding it from public disclosure as required by 10 CFR 2.790(d) or 10 CFR 73.21.
