Attached for your concurrence is a notice of violation
to the U. S. Geological Survey.

The inspection report recommends that the licensee be cited
for noncompliance with 10 CFR 20.401(b), "in that records
were not maintained of the surveys conducted after decon-
tamination to assure that all plots contained radiation
levels less than 0.1 mr/hr." Since 10 CFR 20.201(b) does
not require licensee to conduct such surveys, we have not
cited the licensee as recommended. We are, therefore,
deleting this citation. However, we have added a citation
of noncompliance with 10 CFR 30.41(a).

The subject report also recommends that the licensee be cited
for noncompliance with License Condition No. 6B3, "in that
in addition to mixed fission products, the licensee used
strontium 85, iodine 131 and cesium 137 in hydrologic runoff
studies at Project Chariot site, Cape Thompson, Alaska."
Inasmuch as strontium 85, iodine 131 and cesium 137 are
fission products, we have not cited the licensee for
noncompliance as recommended.
