Gentlemen:

We have received Source Material License No. STB-440, as renewed October 12, 1967.

We feel that an exemption to Subparagraph 20.203 (f)(2) of 10 CFR 20 is necessary. The nigerian materials are presently in storage in relatively remote areas of our plant and these areas are roped off and properly marked with radiation signs. Since we have not been required to comply with this subparagraph in the past, we would have to survey these materials and mark approximately three thousand containers with the appropriate information. In all probability, these materials will be disposed of within the next two to three years and no definite plans for further processing these materials have been developed to date. It is therefore requested that an exemption to Subparagraph 20.203 (f)(2) of 10 CFR 20 be granted at this time.
