
Dear Ms. Jackson:

By NRC letter dated March 28, 1985, Houston Lighting & Power Co. (HL&P) was requested to submit application fees for NRC License No. 42-23140-01. A fee of \$1,160.00 will cover sections of the license which authorize HL&P to leak test sources and calibrate instruments for other companies and organizations.

That same letter also asked if the special nuclear materials and source material authorized by the license are used in connection with the leak test and calibration services. Only the Pu-239 is foreseen as ever being used for such services for other companies and organizations. Therefore, a fee of \$350.00 will satisfy this requirement.

A check in the amount of \$1,510.00 will be submitted under separate cover to satisfy the requirements above.
