Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated November 19, 1982; letters dated March 10, 1983, April 5, 1983, May 24, 1983, November 16, 1983, December 9, 1983, October 3, 1983, and February 2, 1984; letter with attachments dated February 21, 1983; letter dated May 16, 1984; letter with attachments dated August 3, 1984, and letters dated October 31, 1984, November 27, 1984, December 5, 1984, February 4, 1985 and April 15, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
