Dear Mr. Hudec:

This is in response to your letter requesting an extension of the expiration date on component export license XCOM0232. The license authorizes the export of specially designed and prepared parts and components for use in a nuclear reactor except assembled pressure vessels, primary coolant pumps, fuel charging and discharging machines and control rods. The ultimate consignee is the Zorita Nuclear Power Plant in Spain.

Since "specially designed and prepared parts and components" under the NRC's export jurisdiction can now be exported to Spain under the general license in 10 CFR 110.26, it is not necessary to use the specific license as your authority to export the component. As you noted in your letter, the "balance-of-plant" items which this license covered at the time of original issuance on July 6, 1979 are now under the export licensing jurisdiction of the Department of Commerce (DOC). You should, therefore, apply to the DOC for a specific license to export the balance-of-plant items.

On the basis of the foregoing, it has been determined that a license amendment will not be issued. If you have any questions regarding this determination, please call Betty Wright at 301/504-2342.
