Notice of Oral Argument

In response to requests of Suffolk County and the Governor of New York, the Commission will hear oral argument from the County, the State, the applicant, and the NRC staff on:

1. Whether to reconsider CLI-85-1;
2. Whether the Shoreham alternate AC system should be treated as vital equipment during Phases III and IV of low-power testing; and
3. Whether the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board should have affirmed the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board dismissal of physical security contentions for lack of specificity and basis.

In addition, the Commission is especially interested in knowing what, if anything, would be left of the already-admitted physical security contentions if the Commission should decide that the alternate AC system need not be treated as vital equipment.

The argument will take place on Tuesday, June 4, 1985, at 2:00 p.m., in the Commission's 11th-floor conference room at 1717 H Street,

NW. Each party will have fifteen minutes in which to present its views (rebuttal time may be reserved). The order of argument shall be as follows: -


1. New York State;
