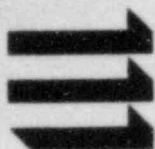

Dear Ms. Wright,

On May 15, 1985, license number XSNM02212 was issued to us authorizing the export of 704.894 kilograms of uranium-235 contained in 22,000 kilograms of uranium. We thank you and all involved for the very timely issuance.

Since the issuance, we have received the final actual quantities from U.S. Department of Energy and have found that additional quantities are required.

With this in mind, we request that an amendment to the above referenced license be issued authorizing an additional 10 kilograms of uranium-235 and 22 kilograms of uranium making the total authorized quantities 714.894 kilograms of uranium-235 contained in 22,022 kilograms of uranium.
