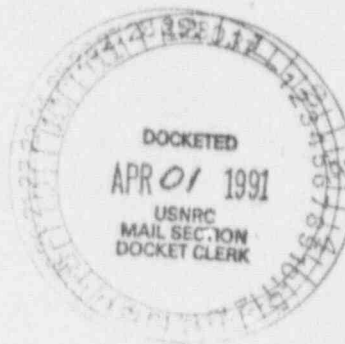

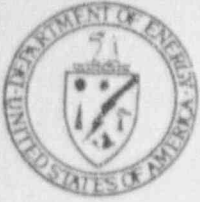

- o TAC Calculations (to be sent under separate cover)

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
