Dear Mr. Starostecki:

NRC Inspection 85-25 was recently conducted at Shoreham by Mr. Walter Martin. During this inspection, a question was raised regarding the qualifications of Security Alarm Station Operators. This was due to the fact that a low overall grade average was attained on the Alarm Station Operator's test, which is required only for security personnel who are alarm station operators. A review of the qualification test revealed questions regarding functions that were not within the scope of the Operators' day-to-day duties.

The Security Alarm Station Operating procedures were revised and a new examination was developed for requalifying all Alarm Station Operators. As agreed, this was to be accomplished and the results forwarded to NRC, Region I, by July 15, 1985.

All Security Alarm Station Operators have been tested using the new examination which reflects the crucial tasks performed in the operation of the Central and Secondary Alarm Stations. Twenty-five (25) Security Alarm Station Operators were tested and



twenty-three (23) passed with an overall average grade of 88 percent. The two individuals who failed have been relieved of all duties as Security Alarm Station Operators.
