Dear Mr. Noonan:

As requested by NRC letter dated June 6, 1985 concerning Small Break LOCA Analysis, please be advised that the CPSES FSAR will be revised to state that Texas Utilities Generating Company is a member of the Westinghouse Owners Group (WOG). The FSAR will additionally reference WCAP-10079 and WCAP-10054 stating that the NOTRUMP code will be used to demonstrate that the previous small break analyses performed for CPSES using the WFLASH code are conservative. This demonstration will be performed generically as part of the WOG generic studies program (II.K.3.31) which is scheduled as follows:


Commencement of generic studies program (II.K.3.31) - June 3, 1985.

Submittal of WOG generic studies WCAP report - May 21, 1986.

The generic studies WCAP report will be referenced in the CPSES FSAR to complete TMI Action Item II.K.3.31.
