
Dear Mr. Cooper:

Per our meeting of 1/27/93, Oncology Services Corporation requests permission to have the manufacturer remove the sources from the HDR units at the Indiana Cancer Center, The Life Care Cancer Center, The Exton Cancer Center and the Mahoning Valley Cancer Center. These sources are near or beyond their useful life. It is my understanding that this could be scheduled by the manufacturer for next week pending approval.

Today, I contacted each Medical Director to reconfirm that the HDR units are secured and that the keys to the HDR units are secure in the possession of the Medical Directors. Since the manufacturer will require the keys to remove the sources, they will be retained by each Medical Director until further notice. I spoke with Dr. Susan Shankman regarding this today.
