
Dear Mr. Vassallo

I have recently filed a Petition with regard to a licensing amendment for the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, Plymouth, Massachusetts. The amendment would increase the K-effective limit for the spent fuel storage pool for normal operation for 0.90 to 0.95.

The Federal Register announcement states the request for the amendment was dated April 12, 1985. I would appreciate it very much if you could send me a copy of the amendment request and any evaluation the NRC has done with regard to it. It would be a big help to me in understanding why the Commission feels this step does not decrease a significant safety limit in the plant, which is its current conclusion.
