He stated that because he has already paid the annual fee for the license, he wants to keep the license for another year.



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**Summary:** Mr. Sockol sent a form 314 and a document attached to it that indicated that they disposed of I-125 waste after storing for only one year, and that drums containing H-3 waste were "removed" from the facility. The survey results did not include the type of instrumentation that was used to analyze wipe samples. I called Mr. Sockol to request that he provide the following information:

- (1) Dates when I-125 waste drums were closed for decay in storage;
- (2) Dates when these drums were disposed off as ordinary trash;
- (3) Dates when H-3 waste drums were removed;
- (4) Waste broker who removed this waste, and documentation;
- (5) Survey instruments used to analyze wipe samples, and their efficiencies

He stated that their technologists had performed these surveys. He will send the requested information soon. I gave him RI fax number (610) 337 5269, so that he can fax the information to expedite the termination request.



**Facility Monitoring Survey-1995**

A Wipe Test was used to monitor the facility locations as follows.

Moisten two swabs for  $^{125}\text{I}$  and  $^3\text{H}$  (i.e. Q-Tips, filter papers, or equivalent) with alcohol

Label 12x75 mm tubes and scintillation vials corresponding to each area of the facility to be monitored

Wipe the entire area gently with a damp swab and place one swab in the corresponding tube and the other in the corresponding scintillation counting vial

Count each tube for 1 minute in the Gamma Counter and record CPM and count each vial for 1 minute in the Beta Counter

Document all information and keep on file.

**Waste Management -1995**

**Disposal of Radioactive Waste**

All liquid or water-soluble waste and expired materials were absorbed as solid radioactive waste and handled as solid waste.

All solid  $^{125}\text{I}$  waste was stored in a separate labeled container for one year and subsequently disposed of as cold waste. The containers were labelled "Radioactive- ( $^{125}\text{I}$ ) GammaWaste" were monitored for activity at the time of storage, sealed and the disposal date clearly indicated.

$^3\text{H}$  labelled compounds in liquid filled scintillation vials were stored in waste containers labelled "( $^3\text{H}$ ) Radioactive Beta Waste" with initial activity at the time of storage. All containers were initially monitored, sealed and subsequently removed from the facility.


Subject: Status of Termination of License






