Attached is information to support our request to amend U.S. NRC Materials License No. 07-00455-02 with the following change:


Removal of a satellite location from the Experimental Station license (Condition No. 10 C) and transfer of two Am-241 sealed sources to the license of Sterling Diagnostic Imaging Inc., Building 600, Glasgow Business Community, Route 896, Glasgow, DE 19702.

The DuPont Experimental Station is requesting that its license, US. NRC. Materials License 07-00455-02, be amended to remove Condition No. 10 C. With the upcoming approval of Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc's license application for the two Am-241 sealed sources, the Experimental Station no longer needs to maintain a satellite location at the Glasgow Business Community.

Under separate cover a check in the amount of \$660.00 was submitted on August 6 by Pamela Meitner, DuPont Legal. Check number 52705162 is payable to the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

Supporting Information on NRC License Amendment Request

The DuPont Company divested segments of its businesses during the months of March and April, 1996. As part of this divestiture a small operation was relocated to Building 600 in the Glasgow Business Community, on Route 896. The operation uses two devices containing specified quantities of licensed byproduct material and had been located for many years at the DuPont Experimental Station, which is approximately 20 miles from the Glasgow Business Community. Both the operation and its personnel had been transferred as part of the divestiture process and had become a part of Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc.

Following the granting of amendment #61 of NRC License No. 07-00455-02 to include Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc.'s (SDII) operation at Building 600, the devices were transferred there. They were owned and operated by Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc. in accordance with the license conditions, but were controlled by DuPont. A Memorandum of Understanding between DuPont and Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc. indicated Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc. agreed to abide by the conditions of the DuPont Experimental Station license. It also stated that DuPont allowed Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc. to conduct its activities under the DuPont Experimental Station license. As stated within the Memorandum, the Memorandum of Understanding will be concluded with the NRC's amendment of the DuPont Experimental Station license and the granting of the SDII license.

The operation at the Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc. site is similar to the set up used for many years at the DuPont Experimental Station. It makes use of two devices, a 10 mCi Am-241 sealed source and a 14 mCi Am-241 sealed source, which are not designed to emit alpha particles. The devices, or their equivalent, will be listed and used under the conditions of SDII's license, once granted. Building 600, sold to Sterling Diagnostic Imaging, Inc. on March 29, 1996, has not previously contained licensed radioactive material. Leak tests for the two Am-241 sealed sources have been negative, therefore no decommissioning plan is necessary.
