Dear Mr. Camper:

The purpose of this letter is to request prior approval from the Commission for the transfer of all of the outstanding stock in Temet USA, Inc. Corporation from the management team to Palomar Medical Technologies, Inc. (Palomar). This transaction which began August 16, 1995, before the license was issued, with the interim transfer of all of the corporation stock from Temet Oy to the management team comprised of Temet USA, Inc. officers, is scheduled for completion on or about March 15, 1996. Because of the short time left before the scheduled completion of the above described transaction, I am asking for the expedited review and approval of our transfer of stock to Palomar to facilitate an expeditious review of our request, the following information is provided.

1. The corporate name has been changed to Sensor Applications, Inc. On January 5, 1996, the Delaware Secretary of State certified a name change from Temet USA, Inc. to Sensor Applications, Inc. A copy of the certificate is attached. However the corporation to whom the License is issued is still in existence and remains the same.
2. Richard C. Krahe, Radiation Safety Officer, remains the licensee contact at 703-759-6000.
3. There are no changes in the Radiation Safety Officer or in other key personnel engaged in license activities.
4. The name change has had no effect on the existence of the corporation.
5. The transaction resulting in the transfer of stock from Temet Oy to the management team is described in the first paragraph of this letter.
6. The change in stock ownership has not and will not result in changes in the corporate organization, structure responsible for management oversight, control, or radiological safety of licensed materials. The location of use, facilities, equipment, and procedures are unchanged from the information submitted in documents referenced in the license.
7. There will be no change in the use, possession, or storage of licensed material under either normal operating procedures or emergency procedures.
8. There is no change in organization, location, facilities, equipment, procedures, or personnel that would require a license amendment.

9. All surveillance items and records shall be current at the time of transfer. All records generated prior to the change of stock ownership shall be retained by the Corporation.
10. All records that could concern the safe and effective decommissioning of our facility and public dose shall be maintained at our current licensed location.
11. No contamination exists in our facility.
12. No decontamination plans or financial assurance agreements are required.
13. The Corporation shall continue to abide by all representations made to the NRC by Temet USA, Inc. No open inspection items exist. Sensor Applications, Inc. is the same corporate entity continues to accept full liability for decontamination and decommissioning of our facilities.
14. By means of this letter Sensor Applications, Inc. acknowledge the requirements as a licensee and advises you of the proposed sale of stock to Palomar.
15. Sensor Applications, Inc. shall continue to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations and commitments contained in our license.

As stated above, this is a transfer of ownership of stock in the corporation and is not a transfer of license to a different entity. Sensor Applications, Inc. shall continue to be responsible for all licensed activities.
