Gentlemen:

This is in reference to your client's, Bomar Resources, Inc., request for a source material license dated July 18, 1984. Following our discussions including our most recent telephone conversation on January 15, 1985, I have concluded that Bomar Resources, Inc. will apparently require a license only for possession and use of source material incident to transfer and delivery of source material to a carrier.

Upon issuance of this license, Bomar Resources, Inc., would not be authorized to receive at, possess at, use at, or transfer material from its own facilities. The license would authorize Bomar Resources, Inc. to receive title to, own, or deliver source material to a carrier. In addition, pursuant to the exemption in Section 110.11 of Part 110, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Bomar Resources, Inc. would be permitted to import source material as described on the license. It appears that a specific license to export source material will be required. Therefore, I am transferring a copy of your application to the attention of Betty Wright, Office of International Programs (301-492-7984). You may wish to contact her for additional information about export licensing.

In your application you indicated that Ledoux and Company, who holds NRC License No. SMC-1181 would actually possess and store source material imported by Bomar Resources, Inc. A review of this license shows that Ledoux and Company is currently authorized to possess only up to 500 kilograms of natural uranium and 400 kilograms of thorium. Your application indicates the necessity to possess up to 1500 kilograms of either uranium or thorium. License No. SMC-1181 is currently being renewed. Therefore, we are requesting by letter (copy enclosed) that Ledoux and Company confirm that they wish the additional authorizations requested in your application.

In order to complete our review of your application, we need the following additional information:

1. Please describe the methods Bomar Resources, Inc. will use to assure that transportation of source material will be in accordance with Section 71.5, Part 71, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations (copy enclosed).

2. Please describe the methods that Bomar Resources, Inc. will use to assure that licensed materials are only transferred to authorized recipients as required by Section 40.51 of Part 40 (copy enclosed).
3. Please confirm that the total quantity of thorium or uranium requested is 1500 kilograms and that Ledoux and Company will apply for a change in License No. SMC-1181 to authorize storage of the material.

Please reply in duplicate to this office within thirty days of the receipt of this letter. Please refer to Control No. 02681 in your response.
