
To Whom it may concern,

I am sending you a Reply to a Notice of Violation in reference to a violation during our recent inspection on August 27 & 28 1996. 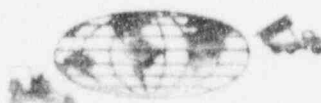
I/we have started a radiation protection program to be conducted on a quarterly basis for all personal and equipment. This as of October 1, 1996.
